REGISTRATION/CLASS INFORMATION:

- ** Pre-Registration fee is \$8.00 per car. Registration day of show at the gate is \$10.00 per car. Cut-off date is September 6th. All Pre-Registered cars are guaranteed a dash plaque.
- ** Registration from 9:00 AM until 12:00 NOON. Cars must be at the registration tables by noon to be judged.
- ** Owners responsible for picking their class. TSMA members can only guide you. You may not change class once entered onto the show field, unless you do not meet the criteria for the class decided by a member of the club.

JUDGING INFO: During judging all trunks and hoods are to be open and convertible tops up. Cars with For Sale Signs on the show field will not be judged.

MODEL CAR CONTEST: There is no registration fee. Each participant is allowed to enter up to 3 automobile models that they assembled.

Awards (1st, 2nd and 3rd) in Junior and Adult classes. Junior class is up to age 21 and the adult class is age 22 and older. An award for best auto related diorama and large-scale automobile will also be awarded.

FLEA MARKET AREA INFO: The space size will be a 20' x 20' area for \$10.00 per space. Flea Market spaces must be **pre-registered and paid by September 6th**. Vendors must be on the show field by 9:00 AM. For more information, call Crissy at (570) 668-0323.

CAR CORRAL SPACES: Cost is \$10.00 per vehicle.

TENTS AND/OR UMBRELLAS MAY BE PUT UP AFTER 12:00 NOON IF SPACE IS AVAILABLE AND THE JUDGES HAVE AMPLE ROOM TO MOVE AROUND THE SHOW CARS

SPECIAL CLASS NOTES:

- ** Classes 1 – 6 are open to stock production cars and trucks.
- ** Class 2 – all factory-original makes and models are allowed in this class except 1955, 1956 and 1957 Chevy's – See Class 7.
- ** The following classes will be judged factory-original condition: Classes 1 to 15.
- ** The following classes will be judged as modified: Classes 16 to 29.
- ** Vehicles in classes 16, 17 and 18 are from years 1900 – 1948 and are modified.
- ** Class 29 Pro Street (1900 – Present) was created for cars with any of the following: blowers, fuel injection, narrowed rears, roll bars, cut frame rails, other rear suspension modifications, and major exterior and/or interior modifications.
- ** Class 24 Nostalgia (1949-1964) was created for cars with any one of the following body modifications: Frenching, chopping, louvers, flame paint jobs, etc. all found on Customs and Lead Sleds or Flame Throwers.
- ** Class 27 Special Interest Class: This is an open class and will be judged on appearance.

DIRECTIONS: (CAR SHOW SIGNS WILL BE POSTED)

FROM THE NORTH: Follow Rt. 309 to center of Tamaqua. Turn Right at center of town & follow Rt. 209 out of town. After 4 miles on Rt. 209 turn Left at intersection & follow 3 miles to Heisler's.

FROM THE SOUTH: Follow Rt. 309 N over the Blue Mtn. Turn Left onto Rt. 895 at bank. Follow Rt. 895 through New Ringgold (approx. 8 miles). Turn Right after cement bridge. Bear Right at 3-way & follow 4 miles to Heisler's.
