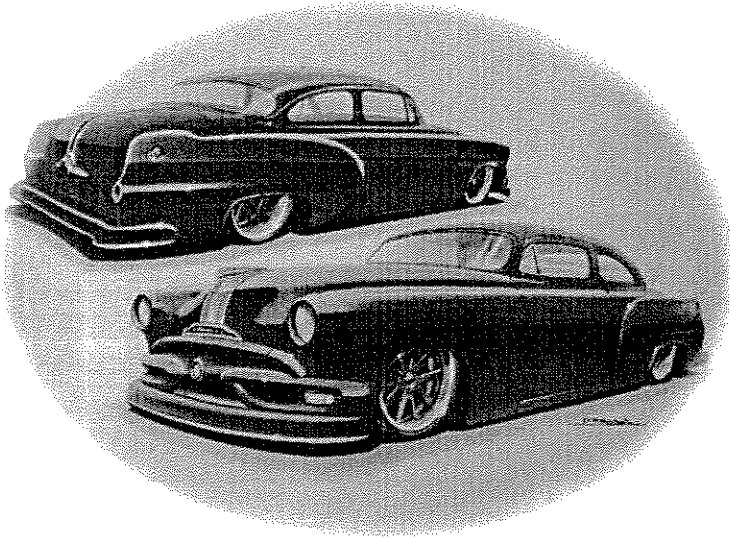

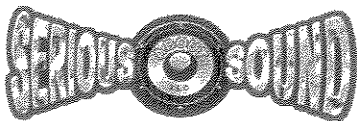
Tickets are not tax deductible.
